**Chad Honeycutt** - *Assistant Director of External Affairs*

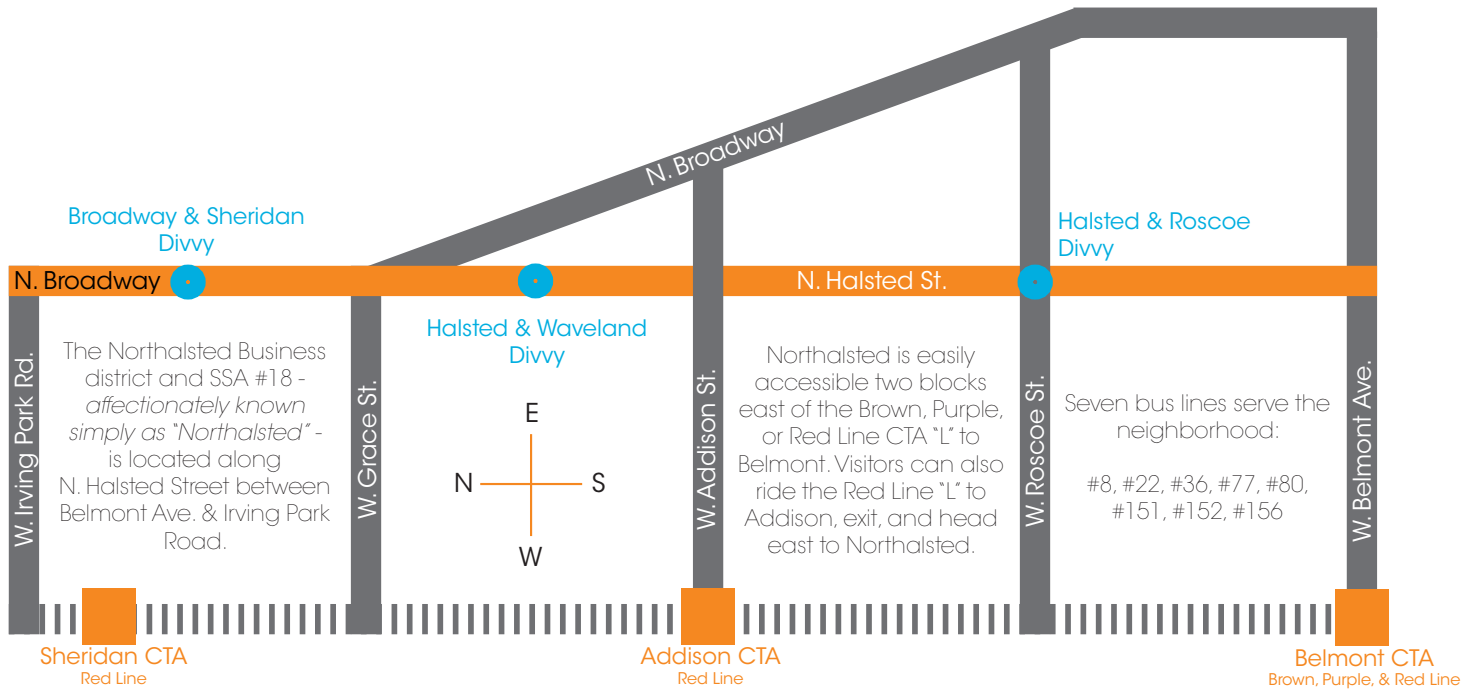
**Eric Santiago** - *Assistant Director of Internal Affairs*

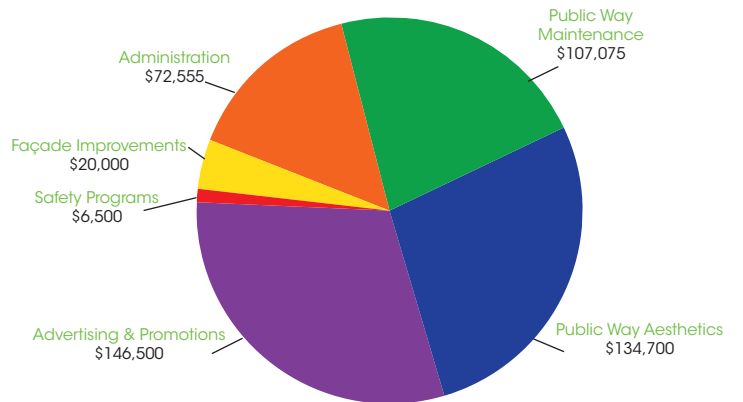

In the City of Chicago, a Special Service Area (SSA) is a local tax district that funds enhanced services and programs, which are paid for by a localized property tax levy within a contiguous area. The enhanced services and programs are in addition to those currently provided through or by the City of Chicago. Each SSA is governed by a local commission which oversees and recommends the annual services, budget, and Service Provider Agency to the City.
